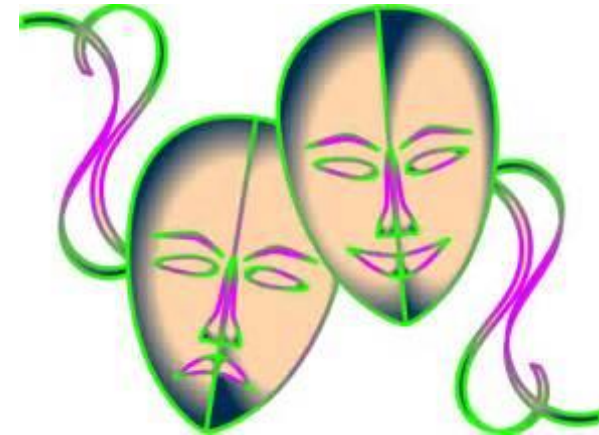

THE QUAY SUMMER SCHOOL OF PERFORMING ARTS

A chance to learn and refine performance skills in acting, movement and music through classes, workshops and performance. As in previous years there will be two performances, but the Saturday will be a shorter day.

CLASSES

There will be a number of general acting and movement classes to develop more awareness of:

- General acting techniques, body language and gesture
- The dynamic range of the voice
- Creating a character and learning improvisation techniques
- Stage discipline and creativity and working as a team.

WORKSHOPS

In addition to the general classes, there will be a series of 75 minute workshops concentrating on specific aspects of theatre performance. Students can choose to participate in up to **FOUR** of these disciplines. The workshop titles are:

- **Dance** – A movement workshop exploring different dance techniques
- **Working with Props** – Playing games and creating scenes using a seemingly ordinary selection of props and objects!
- **Directing** – Sit in the Director's chair and make decisions about staging and interpreting a scene!
- **Musical Theatre** – A chance to develop your skills as a singer, actor and dancer all rolled into one!
- **Stagecraft** -New to the theatre? Pop along to this workshop to play games on the stage to improve your vocalisation, physicality and confidence on stage. Perfect for beginners and the experienced!
- **Improv Comedy** – Learn the basics and then build up your improvising skills with games, songs and even improvised raps!
- **Stomp Workshop**– Learn how to create physical theatre using percussive sounds & rhythms with nothing more than yourself and everyday objects.
- **The Actor's Voice** – Want to improve your performance and vocal skills? We'll play around with breathing, relaxation & learn how to free your voice onstage
- **Storytelling** - Actors are amazing storytellers, but what makes a great story to tell? Come & spin a few yarns!

PERFORMANCE

This year we let our imaginations run riot and wonder **What If?** imagining what might have occurred if something had or had not happened. For example, imagine the world now if the Internet had never been invented, if animals could talk or if all conspiracy theories were true!

There will be TWO performances and they will take place on the Friday and Saturday at 6.00pm on the Quay Theatre stage. All the students will be involved in the performance and have opportunities to sing, dance and act.

It should be noted that this is a workshop performance – not a finished product – and aims to demonstrate the skills learnt during the week. Tickets for the show will be on sale for from the Box Office at £6.00 per Adult and £4.00 per Child.
